- Contact Directory: Mr. Fitzgerald gave a brief overview of the directory; this is also available on the DETSA website
- Chapter Directory: Gives all the active chapters present in Delaware and how to contact them
- National TSA Affiliation: Advisors can affiliate sometime between now and April; will get leadership information. There are three levels of affiliation
- Conference Memo: April 13th-April 14th at the State Fairgrounds in Harrington from 8 am to 5 pm. Memo will change because the fees are not being announced for now
- Tentative Events Chart: guests have taken a look at the TSA Planning Calendar for the 2015-2016 For Clarification:
- If a high school teacher wants desktop publishing, they need to talk to the state advisors
- CAD 2D Design will be kept at 5 members, but less can participate
- Fashion Design: will be added on the list to be considered
- March 7th: Mr. Fitz will email information out to advisors with questions about design brief or a test (for HS)
- Children's Stories: need to check whether that is a state or national event
- New events proposed
 - Electric Dragsters Description: hand-made dragsters using electric motors
 - -Won't be on for this year because more planning is needed and advisors need to think it through
- Catapult Design Event: you make catapult at the school, students practice at school, and they perform at the state conference

Policy Presented

- If you have students who want to do an event which is not done in Delaware and is a national event (ex. Biotechnology Design), you can still offer it in a classroom and teachers can decide if they want to turn it in for the National Conference if it says *per chapter*; if it says *per state*, state advisors have to decide if it can be turned to Nationals

Final Notes:

- Need to see if students are interested in SciVis and STEM Animation
- Conference is moved up by two weeks, which means everything else is moved up by two weeks
