

Official TSA Attire - Most Formal

Blazer: navy blue with official TSA patch.
Tie: scarlet red imprinted with official TSA logo (for males). Shirt or blouse: white, button-up with turn down collar. Pants or skirt: light gray. Dark socks: black or dark blue. Shoes: black dress shoes (unacceptable: athletic shoes, combat or work boots). Sandals: females may wear black open toe shoes or sandals.

Professional TSA Attire - Less Formal

Shirt: males or females, button-up with turn down collar (unacceptable: t-shirt, polo or golf shirt). Blouses: females only. Ties: males required, females optional.

Dress Pants: (unacceptable: jeans, baggy pants, exterior pocket pants). **Dresses/Skirts:** females only (length even with tips of one's fingers), **Dark Socks:** black or dark blue. **Shoes:** dress shoes or boots (unacceptable: athletic shoes, combat or work boots). **Sandals:** females may wear open toe shoes or sandals.

Business Casual TSA Attire - Least Formal

Same as professional attire, however a tie is not required, and the shirt or blouse may be a polo or golf shirt. (Unacceptable: t-shirt or shorts).
